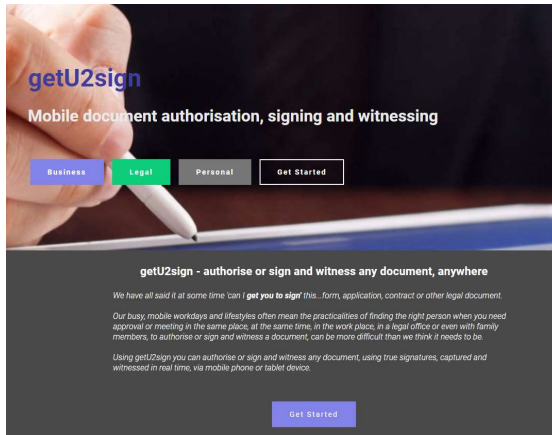


How to start signing with GetU2sign



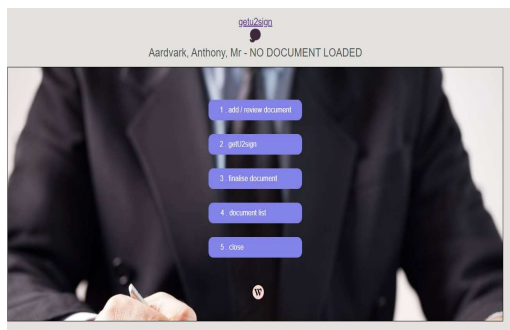
Start with getU2sign

To **get started**, complete the **getU2sign form** and **either**:

Buy credits: Enter the number of documents you want signed now or a bundle to meet your document signing needs for any period e.g. 1 or as many as you need. Please refer to **getU2sign.com** for current per document pricing and terms and conditions of use.

After completing your details and number of credits needed you will be redirected to the ANZ bank card payment to process your credit card (Visa or Mastercard) for payment.

After purchasing getU2sign credits, you will be returned to the getU2sign get started page. Re-enter your details (usually this is saved in your browser memory – so just enter the first letters of your name to autofill the form) and then go to [Use credits](#) – to start a document signing.

Use Credits: If you have **previously purchased getU2sign credits** when you enter your information (in the form) getU2sign will recognise your details and retrieve your current credits balance, when you click USE Credits. If your credits balance is zero, you just need to buy one or more credits, to top up your balance and continue.

Already have getU2sign credits

When you have getU2sign credits – **enter your details in the form** and **click USE credits**.

getU2sign will retrieve your credit balance and if more than zero, you will be able to **click login** to start a new signing session.
